## Case for the Luftwaffe Ehrenpokal

## **Description**

The Luftwaffe Ehrenpokal was instituted on 27 February, 1940 for award to Luftwaffe personnel who had already received the EK 1 but whose additional wartime feats didn't warrant the DK or RK. It was presented in the case described here. Note the presentation boxes. When the collector encounters this very scarce accessory it will invariably be the type covered in blue leatherette, pictured below. Boxes in red, said to be early war issue, are extremely rare.
