

## 1939 Spange to the 1914 Iron Cross Second Class First Pattern – Unknown Maker

### Description

For a subsequential award of the Iron Cross Second Class, having been awarded already this class in the World War 1, a clasp (Spange) was issued. The clasp was worn on the black and white ribbon of the Iron Cross Second Class of 1914 in the usual buttonhole of the tunic.

**Type/Pattern** First Pattern

**Remarks:** The first pattern shows concave sides to the date plaque. Also the numeral "3" is distinctly different to the standard pattern. Prongs are arranged vertical and are made in one piece. Wreath with mobile swastika is slightly elongated. Highly detailed feathers and claws. Several "First Pattern" are in existence.

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
