


Spanish Cross in Bronze with Swords C.E. Juncker Berlin

Description

The famous Juncker Company manufactured the Spanish Cross during the war. This one is showing the mark CEJ, stamped on the reverse, within a square. This cross was made in bronze and I think it is an awarded cross. The attach system, hinge and pin, are typical to this maker, thus the grips. Note the 2 cut out eagle swastika.

The Spanish Cross (Spanienkreuz) was instituted on April, 14th 1935 by A. Hitler (14.4.1939, RGBI. IS.1939, 1360). The bronze class was awarded 8462 times during the main Legion Condor return parades in Hamburg and Döberitz.
