

## D.R.A. Sports Badge 1<sup>st</sup> Model in Gold EUGEN MARCUS HOFJUWELIER BERLIN W.8 U.D.LINDEN 31

### Description

The DRA Sports Badge 1<sup>st</sup> Model was instituted in 1913. It was issued in three grades (Bronze, Silver and Gold). They were presented (1913-1914) and (1919-1933) None were issued during WW 1. For the **Gold** they had to pass five parts of a physical test for a further fifteen years beyond the requirements of the Bronze grade, and seven years further beyond that for a Silver grade.

This badge maker "Eugen Marcus" is very rare and attributed with manufacturing the DRA badges in the years 1913-1914. The Gold DRA was awarded approximately 4,200 times.
