

NAVAL COASTAL ARTILLERY WAR BADGE (1941) (Kriegsabzeichen für die Marineartillerie) Schwerin

Description

The Coastal Artillery was composed of shore and land based Naval personnel responsible for coastal and anti-aircraft defense. The badge was instituted on June 24, 1941. The eagle and wreath are gilt, the sea and gun battery are gunmetal grey.

The hinge pin heads of some early examples are flat and 'waffled' (cross-grained), whilst other examples are smooth and conical.
