


## Luftwaffe Radio Operator / Air Gunner Badge "Juncker" C.E. Juncker Berlin SW

### Description

The Luftwaffe Radio Operator / Air Gunner Badge was instituted on 26 March 1936. The Badge was awarded to Air Gunners, Radio Operators and Mechanics who successfully completed two months training or had participated in one of the positions in a minimum of five operational flights. The badge could be awarded sooner should the recipient be wounded on an operational flight. Like the other Luftwaffe badges, regulations prescribed that this badge be worn on the lower left breast pocket of the uniform.
